Leaving Certificate 2023:

Our 6th year students have now completed all their exams and they must be complimented in the effort they made throughout the last two years. This year we have 6th year students applying for courses in medicine, teaching, business courses, science courses and engineering courses to mention a few. Some of our students have already started their apprenticeships. Well done to everyone in the class of 2023.

Junior Certificate Class 2023:

Our third years have now completed their state exams and the vast majority are looking forward now to Transition Year. This decision affords these students time to develop and mature as young people and it affords these students opportunities to taste all Leaving Certificate subjects in preparation for choices to be made in 5th year. Our 3rd years have done exceptionally well, and I congratulate them on finishing third year in a very productive manner.

Summer Reports:

• 1st, 2nd, and 5th year reports are now available to view through the VSware parent app and a hardcopy of your son/daughter's report can be requested from the school if required.

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School Code of Behaviour:

This will issue to all parents/guardians by link before returning to school. A Consent Form will also be attached and all parents/guardians will be required to confirm that they have read through the Code of Behaviour with their son/daughter and will adhere to the Code of Behaviour as outlined.

Note: Facial piercings are not allowed but if piercings are done 6 to 8 weeks in advance of returning to school the piercing will not close thus creating no issue.

School Uniform:

The school uniform can be purchased in Uniform World in Clonmel. Please note that Uniform World have asked that orders should be placed before mid-July.

Note: School PE gear will be distributed from the school Monday 21st of August for 1st years and Tuesday the 22nd for all other year groups.

Afterschool Study:

This will run each day for Junior and Senior Cycle students with separate centres. Study runs from 4pm to 5.45 pm Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Study centers are open from 2pm to 5pm each Wednesday. The cost is €150 per term. (€10 per week)

- Term 1 September to December
- Term 2 January to June

Note: A form will issue in August to apply for evening study.

Way to Pay:

This is our school Parental Payment System. This will allow for payments to be spread over several weeks before school begins.

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School Costs

Please note these are not a voluntary contribution as it goes directly to pay for items listed below.

Annual School Fees Per Student are: €140

- School Insurance
- School Locker
- School Journal
- School Photocopying
- Guest speakers (Internet Safety, Study Skills)
- Cognitive Ability Testing
- Bus costs for students representing the school in extra-curricular activities (A charge may have to be introduced here)

Junior Cycle Book Rental Scheme: €220

- o The cost of the book scheme for 1st vear students will be €220 for three years. This covers the cost of additional books that may be required in 2nd and 3rd year. It is important to note that if the school did not operate a book scheme the cost of books would be €350 plus.
- This also covers Junior Cycle Maths pack (includes scientific calculator) Note: 1st year **Book Rental Scheme** collection Monday 21st of August

Senior Cycle Book Rental Scheme: €180

The cost of the book scheme for 5th year students will be €180 for the two years. This covers the cost of all books that may be required in 5th and 6th year.

Note: 5th year *Book Rental Scheme* collection Wednesday 30th of August

School PE Tracksuit Gear:

- The costs of the new school PE Gear are as follows:
 - €85 for tracksuit bottoms, top and school jersey purchased together is required by all 1st
 - All other Year Groups who require any item of the school PE Tracksuit can purchase them from the school in late August. Mr. Burke has addressed any issue that arose with the

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tracksuit bottoms with suppliers and the option to purchase a straight leg/old style tracksuit pants will be available.

Please note there is no PE classes on timetable for 5th and 6th years next year except those doing PE as an exam subject.

TY Cost:

The fee for the year is €500. All money collected from parents for Transition Year is fully utilised to cover costs of activities undertaken by our Transition Year students throughout the year, but additional cost may have to be charged throughout the year.

Additional Costs:

- Mock Exams for 3rd and 6th years will incur some additional costs.
- Curricular trips may take place throughout the year for certain groups.
- Year group trips may take place at the end of the year.to places such as Tayto Park.
- UK trip may take place for 1st years after Christmas.

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
