## 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> March: One to One meetings:

During the week commencing the 4<sup>th</sup> March there will be one to one meetings with parent/ guardians and your son/daughter in the school. These questions will vary from interests/ hobbies, whether they have siblings in the school and , any medical issues we need to know about and a series of other pieces of information that is necessary for us at this particular stage.

## 15<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> March – CAT (Cognitive Ability Testing) in Coláiste Dún Iacaigh

The next step of the transition process happens between 15<sup>th</sup> and the 22<sup>nd</sup> March when all of our incoming first years will come to the Colaiste for CAT testing. It will give the incoming first years another opportunity to visit the school. A report of the results will be posted home to the parents / guardians on the 22<sup>nd</sup> March which can aid with subject selection.

#### June 23

I will issue a letter to all parents outling start dates for the 2024/2024 academic year, school calendar 2024/2025 and information about book scheme and other relevant information.
