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**Details of School Costs:** 

Free Book Scheme for Incoming 1st and 5th Years:

The Government has introduced a new scheme from the start of the new school year 2025/2026 for 5<sup>th</sup>

years along with incoming 1st Years. Under this scheme all schoolbooks and core classroom resources for

post primary students in Junior Cycle and Senior Cycle years will be provided directly to students by their

school. Guidance has been issued to schools on the scheme and is available at:

**Government Book Scheme Information** 

Funding under this scheme will not include the purchase of digital devices. The schoolbooks will be on

loan to the students and must be returned at the end of the school year or at the end of Junior

Cycle/Senior Cycle or if the student leaves the school. It is important that schoolbooks are kept in good

condition so they can be reused. All books being introduced in September 2025 will be bar coded.

In late August the school will distribute all textbooks to 1<sup>st</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> year students as required and any

additional textbooks required in subsequent years will also be provided. Replacement books will not be

provided.

This funding received from parents is essential for us in providing key services throughout the course of

the year and it is not a Voluntary Contribution.

**Phone Pouch/Locks:** 

These have been collected from all year groups except Transition Year. They will be re-distributed again

at the start of the school year. Students who do not return to school with a phone pouch will be required

to purchase a new one at a cost of €30. The same practice will apply to school locks that have not been

returned by students.

**Transition Year Cost:** 

The fee for the year is €500. All money collected from parents for Transition Year is fully utilised to cover

costs of activities undertaken by our Transition Year students throughout the year. The only cost not

included is an option of travelling on an end of year overnight trip to Derry.

**School Uniform Cost:** 

The school uniform can be purchased in Uniform World, Clonmel. Please note that Uniform World have

asked that orders should be placed before mid-July. Please note shoes must be brown, black or navy and

no white runners are allowed.

Please note that only tapered pants will be kept in limited stock at the school; skinny pants must be ordered online. There is also the option to purchase shorts and socks for students involved in extracurricular activities, though these are not compulsory.

To ensure your child has the correct PE uniform for the year ahead, we strongly encourage you to complete your order by June 13th using the link provided. Stock will be limited in school, and we cannot guarantee availability after this date.

**School Jacket:** (dates for collection will issue later)

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The online window to purchase our school jacket is now open. These will be delivered to the school for

collection in August. Please retain copy of receipt issued to your phone when collecting your Jacket. Our

Parents Association will also operate a swap shop at nominal cost before the end of the state exams. The

school jacket proved very popular this year and while we ran short of some sizes, I thank all

parents/guardians for your co-operation with this initiative.

**Afterschool Study:** 

This will run each day from 4pm to 5.45 pm Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday and from 2pm to 5pm

each Wednesday. The cost is €150 per term.

The school offers an activity/study afternoon every Monday for 1st year students called Junior Dun. This

runs from 3.45pm to 5.45pm. It is great way for students to get to meet new friends partake in an

afterschool activity and be guided with homework and study.

Note: A form will issue in August to apply for Junior Dun and the cost is €70 per term.

**Pre Examination Papers/Corrections:** 

Mock Exams for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> years will cost €50 per student. This is to cover the purchase of exam papers

and corrections. The school has worked with Dublin Examinations Board over the last number of years.

**Laptops 5<sup>th</sup> Years:**

evening was held in our school on the 26<sup>th</sup> May. The company providing the laptops are Olive for Education

and the cost is €684 per device. A deposit will be required to be paid by the end of June and they will be

introduced fully into 5<sup>th</sup> year around the October break. The aim was to give families a window of 5 months

to pay for the device. The local credit union may provide finance for this device if requested.
